If you require an Anniversary Mass, please check in the sacristy with the Priest or the Sacristan after Mass times or phone 8316016

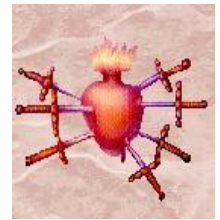
**Remembrance Plates on Church Pews:**

The purpose of the **Devotion of the Seven Sorrows** is to promote union with the sufferings of Christ through union with the special suffering that Our Lady endured because she was the Mother of God. By uniting ourselves with both the Passion of Christ and His holy Mother, we enter into Jesus' Heart and honor Him greatly; He is more honored because we have honored His Mother.

The **Seven Dolors** are taken from Scripture events and the devotion has a long history, although it was not officially promulgated by the Church until the early nineteenth century.

Mary, Mother of God, your sorrows were ordained by God from all eternity as part of the penalty to be paid for sin and were to mingle with the suffering of your Son in the great sacrifice which was to redeem the world.
